

We hereby declare that the hose **912904.....00 VACUPRESS SUPERELASTIC**

is made on PVC with embedded galvanized steel spiral with polyester yarn reinforcement

Smooth inner and outer surfaces.

Operating temperature -25°C to + 60°C.

Avoid contact of food with the heads and outer surface of the tube.

The hoses must be sterilised prior to use.

Use: delivery and suction of liquid foodstuffs

The hoses are suitable for contact with aqueous food, acid and alcohol (up to 28%) for which A, B and C simulants are provided, for a maximum of 24 hours repeated contact at the maximum temperature of 40°C.

(For the designation of the food a product or group of products has been chosen in relation to the food categories listed in Directive 85/572/EEC, transposed by Ministerial Decree no. 220 of 26/04/1993, and subsequent amendments – See note at the end of the document on Article 23 of Reg. (EU) no. 10/2011).

In compliance

The items mentioned above were manufactured exclusively with substances (monomers, pigments and additives) indicated in the positive lists of the above legislation. The material contains substances subject to restrictions in the laws mentioned and are listed below:

Test conditions:

Simulant : distilled water

Time and Temperature: 2 hours at 40°C (repeated use)

Simulant : acetic acid at 3% in aqueous solution

Time and Temperature: 2 hours at 40°C (repeated use)

Simulant: ethanol at 28% in aqueous solution (*)

Time and Temperature: 24 hours at 40°C (repeated use)

The simulants and test conditions were chosen according to Directives 82/711/EEC and 85/572/EEC and its amendments and the Decreto n. 338 of 22/07/1998. (See note at the end of the document for Article 22 of the Regulation (EU) no. 10/2011 on the Transitory provisions).

The overall migration limit, together with the other specific restrictions to which the monomers and/or additives present in the material may be subject, are respected in the above-mentioned conditions of use. This statement has been supported by analytical tests conducted in accordance with Directives 82/711/EEC, 85/572/EEC and 97/48/EC and Ministerial Decree 21/03/1973 or on the basis of calculations made by considering the content of the substances subject to migration limits. The calculations were made assuming that 1kg of food is in contact with 6 dm² of the material.

There are substances in the hose governed by Regulations (EC) No. 1333/2008 and 1334/2008 and its amendments (substances called "food dual use"):

E 171 Titanium Dioxide;

E 470a Sodium, Potassium And Calcium Salts Of Fatty Acids;

E 479b Thermally Oxidised Soya Bean Oil Interacted With Mono- And Diglycerides Of Fatty Acids;

E 570 Fatty Acids.

According to experimental data and/or theoretical calculations such substances comply with the requirements of Article. 11 of Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 paragraph 3, letters "a" and "b" of D.M. 21/03/1973.

The user of the hose intended for contact with food is responsible for informing the company in writing of any restrictions due to the characteristics of the ingredients (presence of additives and flavourings) of the food product to be transported.

This declaration will be updated in the event of changes in formulation of the material or if the legislative references are modified and updated so as to require a new check for compliance.

NOTE: this declaration has been prepared in accordance with **Art. 22 – paragraph 1**: "Transitory provisions: Until 31 December 2012, the documents referred to in article 16 are based on the basic rules concerning the verification of global and specific migration referred to in Directive 82/711/EEC ..." and **article 23**: "Entry into force and application: ... The provisions referred to in Article 18, paragraphs 2 and 4, and Article 20 apply from 31 December 2012" of Regulation (EU) no. 10/2011.
